Every month, EFPN distributes more than 12,000 food items – and the annual Canstruction Midland event held November 10-14, 2021 made a significant contribution to helping people in need in our community.

High-school and middle-school students from eight local schools competed in the build using STEAM principles to create sculptures entirely out of food items, proving that "one CAN make a difference!"

Their hard work resulted in a contribution of over 10,000 food items to our eight pantries – and People's Choice Award votes generated a monetary donation of nearly \$965. That is enough to provide 320 packs of food for the weekend through our Backpack Buddies program!
