Dear EFPN Supporters and Volunteers,

Thank you for allowing us to be able to serve your neighbors in need of food. 2018 was an exciting and historic year for the Midland County Emergency Food Pantry Network (EFPN). After a few years of discussions and looking at various properties, we purchased the building we were renting. The building will be home for our office, warehouse and the SAMS Pantry sponsored by St. John's Episcopal Church. We could not have made this decision without the generous support of many foundations and individuals. The building is currently in the midst of renovations. When the renovations are completed, we will have expanded warehouse space to better accommodate donations from our very generous community. The temperature-controlled garage will allow us to store fresh produce in more optimal conditions. The building will be handicapped-accessible so clients going to the SAMS pantry will not have barriers. The change also improves the ability to move grocery carts of food in and out of the building. We have installed more efficient lighting, heating and air conditioning, which will result in reduced utility bills. Our overall monthly costs for the facility should be less than renting, allowing us to put more money into our food programs. SAMS Pantry, sponsored by St John's Episcopal Church, will rent a portion of the building from EFPN.

EFPN saw a decrease in food and monetary donations in 2018 (not including one-time building grants). We continue to look for ways to stretch our food dollars and maximize the efficiency of our programs. If funding allows, we will continue to look to expand the Backpack Buddies Program to additional schools and develop other programs to help the food insecure.

Program Highlights for 2018:

- ◆ Senior Delivery recipients increased 40% from January to December. We are grateful to various groups including families with young children who made cards for the senior delivery boxes.
- ◆ There was a slight decrease in people coming to our regular pantries and mobile pantries. People served by the Backpack Buddies Program and Nutritional Supplement Program remained relatively constant.
- ◆ Number of gift certificates provided to clients increased. These allow clients to purchase household or perishable items not available at the pantry.
- ◆ Two additional pre-schools were added to the Backpack Buddies Program: Longview Early Childhood Center and the Pre-Primary Center at Carpenter Street School.
- ◆ Partnered with Home to Stay to provide a box of food to people moving into a new place to live.
- ◆ Initiated stocking the pantry at Windover High School, and continued filling the pantry at the Academic and Career Education Academy.
- ◆ Continued providing boxes of food to the Midland Community Former Offenders Advocacy and Rehabilitation Program to help former offenders re-integrate into our community.
- ◆ A Blessing Box was piloted outside of the North Midland Family Center facility. This is a self serve mini pantry.

The EFPN annual report is filled with lots of numbers. These numbers represent people whose lives have been impacted by your kindness and generosity.

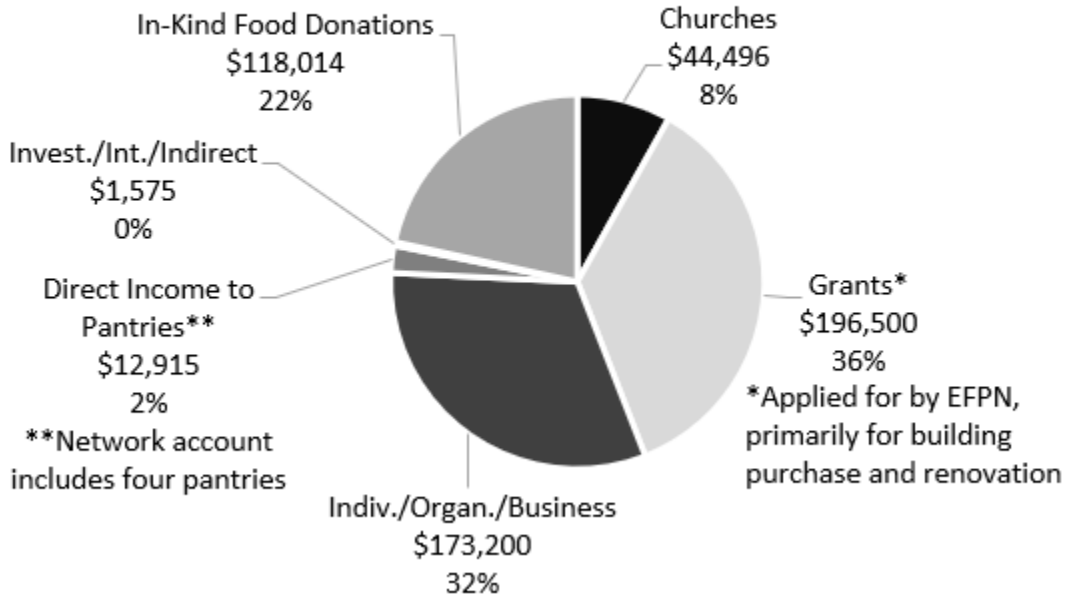

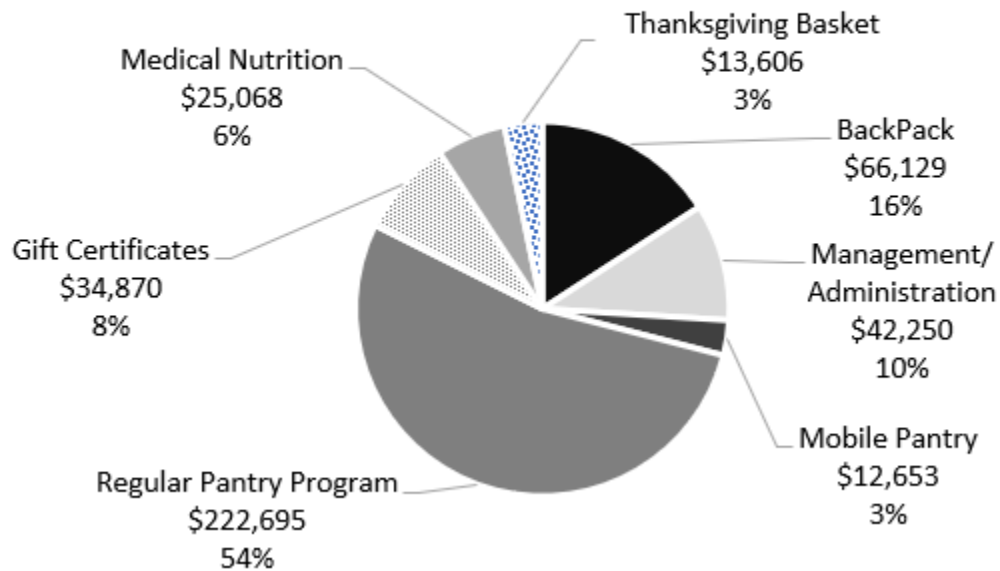

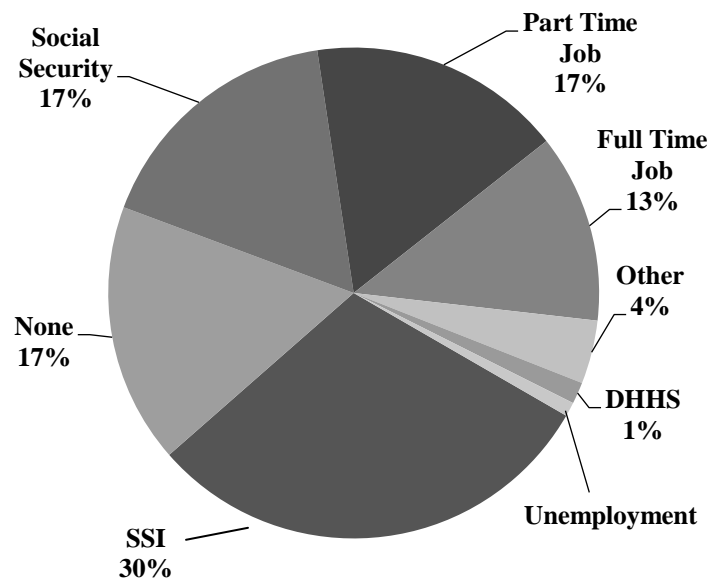
