Every month, MCFAN distributes more than 12,000 food items. The annual Canstruction Midland event held November 12, 2023 made a significant contribution to helping people in need in our community.

High-school and middleschool students from nine local schools competed in the build using STEAM principles to create sculptures entirely out of food items, proving that "one CAN make a difference!"

Their hard work resulted in a contribution of over 13,000 food items to MCFAN. The People's Choice Award votes generated a monetary donation of \$622 - that is enough to provide 155 packs of food for the weekend through our Backpack Buddies program!


