In 2024, MCFAN took a deep dive into evaluating all of our programs to ensure they meet the evolving needs of our community. Our primary goal was to enhance client-focused services while minimizing barriers to food access. As a result, some of our programs underwent name changes, adjustments, and expansions to better serve those who rely on us, and ensure we deliver on our mission of 'always food in every home.'

To further prioritize our clients, we restructured our staffing model, bringing all employees on-site. This transition required updates to our facility, including modifications to our building and a reorganization of our warehouse to better support our pantries.

Through volunteerism, we have not only strengthened these connections, but also increased awareness of food insecurity in our area. Thanks to our dedicated volunteers, we have been able to put food into the hands of those who need it most.






